MYANMAR TOUR
4 NIGHTS / 5 DAYS

Day 01: Yangon – Arrival (D)

Upon arrival at Yangon International Airport, welcome by our local guide and transfer to your hotel. The rest of the time is on your own leisure. This evening, we will enjoy welcome dinner at local restaurant. Stay overnight at hotel in Yangon

Day 02: Yangon – Exploration (B/L)

Breakfast at hotel. Yangon, being the first stop for your tours, has a lot to offer you in a city tour. Today we will visit Yangon's colonial-style city center, Mahabandoola Park and Town Hall. Visit to the historic Shwedagon Pagoda- one of the wonders of the world, towering almost 100m above the city-scape, believed to have been built over 2500 years ago.

Have local cuisine in a nearby restaurant for lunch.

After lunch we will visit the magnificent reclining Buddha at Chauk Htat Gyi, and after a photo stop at the Karaweik Hall, a hamsa-bird-shaped floating barge on Kandawgyi Lake is waiting for your embark. Over the lake, shadow of the grand Shwedagon Pagoda reflects its majesty in a quite different yet amazing way. We will drive back to hotel with a lovely sunset.

Overnight stay at hotel in Yangon.

Day 03: Yangon – Tour (B/L)

Breakfast at hotel. Today we start to visit Kaba Aye pagoda dedicated to the peace in the World and the Maha Pasuna cave where the sixth Buddhist synod took place in 1952.

This afternoon enjoy a city tour by car or rickshaw around the colonial area which is filled with various historical buildings. Stop for a drink at a local teashop, a great place to soak in the local culture and lifestyle, before traveling along the famous Strand Road to the riverside.

Continue to Bogyoke Market, formerly known as Scott's Market, where you can browse through the wide selection of Myanmar handicrafts and other goods (Note: closed on Mondays and public holidays). As today comes to a close, take a stroll around colorful Chinatown and visit one of Yangon's Chinese temples. Overnight at hotel in Yangon

Day 04: Yangon (B/L)

After breakfast at the hotel, leave Yangon and enjoy a scenic journey by road to Bago, 80km to the north west of Yangon. Bago is an ancient capital of a former Mon kingdom dating back to the 6th century. Sightseeing in Bago includes the beautiful 55-meter long reclining Buddha, Shwethalyaung, and the Mon style Shwemawdaw Pagoda, one of the most venerated in Myanmar.

Its spire stands 114m high and is taller even than the Shwedagon Pagoda. Also visit the well-restored former palace Kambozathadi. End the tour of Bago with a walk around the colorful Bago Market. On the way back to Yangon, visit the Allied War Cemetery near Htaukkyan, the final resting place for over 27,000 allied soldiers, and a local woven bamboo factory. Overnight at hotel in Yangon

Back to Yangon and stay overnight in Yangon

Day 05: Yangon – Departure (B)

After breakfast at hotel, you will be transferred to Yangon International airport for your return international departure flight.
